## HISTORY AND PROPHETS OF THE OLD TESTAMENT

1. Comment on five (5) of the items (a)–(j):

(a) “The angel of the Lord said to him, ‘Peace be to you; do not fear, you shall not die’.” (Judges 6:23). (4 marks)

(b) “And Samuel said, ‘Has the Lord as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices as in obeying the voice of the Lord?’” (1 Samuel 15:22). (4 marks)

(c) “David was the son of that Ephrathite of Bethlehem in Judah, named Jesse.” (1 Samuel 17:12). (4 marks)

(d) “So Jeroboam drove Israel from following the Lord and made them commit great sin.” (2 Kings 17:21). (4 marks)

(e) “Behold, a virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.” (Isaiah 7:14). (4 marks)

(f) “Cursed is the man who trusts in man and makes flesh his arm.” (Jeremiah 17:5). (4 marks)

(g) “I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you.” (Ezekiel 36:26). (4 marks)

(h) “They made kings, but not through me.” (Hosea 8:4). (4 marks)

(i) “Behold, the days are coming when the plowman shall overtake the reaper.” (Amos 9:13). (4 marks)

(j) “For who has despised the day of small things?” (Zechariah 4:10). (4 marks)

2. Describe the leadership of Gideon and explain his contribution to Israel’s history. (20 marks)

3. Examine the role of Samuel as both judge and prophet of Israel. (20 marks)

4. Assess the successes and failures of King Hezekiah’s reforms. (20 marks)
