6. Explain six qualifications led to the election of Abubakar Siddiq (r.a) to be a caliph
7. Briefly analyze activities of the four forces worked against the Islamic government under the Prophet (s.a.w).
8. With vivid historical evidence, explain the growth of strong Islamic city states in East Africa.
