- (d) Who lived in the Promised Land before the Israelites took it? (Josh.3:10). Mention four (4) of them.
- (e) “You shall not pass through” (Numb.20:18).
  - (i) Name the speaker.
  - (ii) To whom were the words spoken?
  - (iii) Name the place where these words were spoken.
  - (iv) State the occasion.
- (f) Give a list of people who were buried at Mechpelah, excluding Abraham, Sara and Joseph.
- (g) “We shall surely die for we have seen God.” (Judg.13:22).
  - (i) Who said these words?
  - (ii) To whom were they spoken?
  - (iii) What was the occasion?
  - (iv) What was the outcome?

  - (b) From where and to where were they going?
  - (c) What did the addressee(s) do about their complaint?

  - (b) To whom was he speaking?
  - (c) What was promised to the addressed person?
