# 2.0 PREPARATION OF SPECIMENS

- (a) Prepare two (2) Irish potatoes of about 6 7 cm long. Provide each candidate with both Irish potatoes.
- (b) Use a beam balance to weigh 6 g of table salt for each candidate. Put 3 g on the two separate watch glasses and label each as sample A.
- (c) Use a beaker (400 ml)/cooking pot to prepare the boiling water which will be used by the candidates to boil the specimens during the examination. Place the boiling point in such a way that can be shared by 4-6 candidates.
