Linking functions as political party provides a link between government and people. The views and grievances of the people are channeled through the political party to the government.

Educates the public because any political party is there to educate people on the policies of the existing government and what the party would do if it will be elected into office.

(b) A pressure group is an organized group of people who try to persuade and influence political decision about a particular issue e.g. NGOS like TGNP, TAMWA, TAWLA, etc.

Importance

They provide education of human rights; they make people be aware of their rights such as to participate in social, political and economic activities.

They give legal support to the people who cannot afford to hire lawyers or advocates e.g. TAWLA.

They campaign against bad traditional practices. They are good actors in educating people about effects of bad traditional culture like FGM.

(c) Local government Is the system of self — governance overseen by a

democratically elected body of councilors and is an agent of central government. OR

Local government can be defined as local authority that has power and authority over village, ward, district, municipality, city and urban area.

Importance

To promote active participation of people in various development activities such as building schools, roads, health centers, etc.
To increase awareness and commitment of people in solving their own development problems by giving local people a strong say.
To facilitate and simplify administrative functions, because it is very close to people
Local government acts as a link between local community and central government.
(d) Courtship is a period of relationship between a man and woman before marriage.
Importance
A young person who is unmarried gets an ample time for preparing lo narriage.
it facilitates behavioural changes as this is necessary in order to win a proper partner.
This preparation time enables young people to evaluate their future life together.
It is a good time to establish true love, respect and obedience of both parties.
(e) Road safety education is education which is given or offered to the road users like drivers, pedestrians etc on how to use and observe road signs such as traffic light, zebra crossing, speed limit etc.
Importance
It makes the pedestrians cross the road safely and avoid accidents.

It enables drivers to respect the road signs such as speed limit, speed bumps and avoid driving recklessly. It reduces the number of death and accidents because the drivers, motorcyclists, pedestrians and others pay attention when using the roads. Lessen the burden to the government to incur costs to buy medicine for the injured and to rebuild infrastructure destroyed like roads, railways, etc. (f) Presidential standard is a flag that is used during official ceremonies where the president is in attendance It has a green back ground with a blue border and the coat of arms in the middle. **Importance** It symbolizes the authority of the president. It is a state symbol of the president. (g) Protection of human rights means ensuring that human rights are not violated and abused. **Importance** It helps to regulate and control the power of the government. It promotes democracy. This means the citizens are respected by the government. It encourages people to participate in economic, social, political and cultural activities. It is a source of justice, peace and freedom.

(h) Citizenship Is a state of a person to belong to a particular country like Tanzania or a state of being a citizen of a particular country like Tanzania.
Importance
A citizen receives legal rights for belonging to a certain country are protected as the citizen of that country.
It is the legal way of being recognized as a person belonging to particular country.
The country receives loyalty from its citizens.
The country gets revenue from its citizens through paying taxes. (I) Social life skills Are abilities or competencies of a person to live and interact well with others according to standards and values of a society.
Importance
It helps in maintaining peace and order in the society.
Helps in making proper decisions in life on various issues like friendship, education and career choice. (j) Zebra signs are symbols drawn on the road whereby vehicles stop to allow pedestrians to cross the road.

7. sources of the central government revenue can be identified as follows:-
Direct taxes paid to the government by the employees. This kind of tax is known as pay as you earn (payee).

Indirect taxes such as import and export duties or custom duties and value added tax (VAT).
Loan from domestic financial institutions foreign countries and international financial institutions like IMF, WB and ADB.
Grants which are non-payable funds provided by developed countries to poor countries.
Charges from provision of social services by the government like electricity, water, medical treatment, etc.
License fees, these are documents which validate property ownership by someone.
