1. Choose the correct answer and write its letter in the box provided:

Answer: D. To take care of the family properties

Answer: C. Burning forests

Reason: Burning forests destroys resources instead of valuing and protecting them.

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Answer: C. Pedestrians

Reason: Pedestrians are people who travel by walking along roads.

Answer: B. Planting and conserving trees

Reason: Planting and conserving trees is a safe and positive volunteering activity suitable for children.
